
CAPTIONS

TYPES OF CAPTIONS



QUOTES

- Content should be engaging either a reaction or emotion.
- All factual information (score of game, opponent, dates, etc.) should be in the first sentence or a transition sentence before the quote.
- All quotes must be verbatim. Only stutters and transitional sounds ("um") should be edited out.
- Quotes are surrounded by quotation marks (").
- · The quote ends with a comma not a period or exclamation point!
- · The comma ALWAYS goes inside the quotation mark.
- The quote must be attributed to the person who said it.
- The quote attribution is always "said" never exclaimed, yelled, shouted, whispered, etc. Let the reader decide the intended sentiment.
